

NOTICE OF TENDERING FOR REPAIRS TO WEATHER DAMAGED ROADS IN KENT

Kent Highway Services maintains over 5000 miles of roads in the county. The severe winter and preceding heavy rainfall has resulted in a higher level of damage to the county roads than we would normally anticipate.

To ensure we continue to maintain roads effectively, we are inviting contractors to tender for an opportunity to deliver patching and repairs to roads in Kent.

The total estimated value of the work is £1,000,000 but a further £1,500,000 may become available. The work will be split into 12 contracts, one for each district in Kent.

Contractors can find details of the work and the pre-qualification questionnaire via the South East Business Portal (www.businessportal.southeastiep.gov.uk), or a pack can be obtained by calling the KHS Contact Centre on 08458 247 800.

Formal expressions of interest for tendering must be returned by 2 March 2010 after which, eligible contractors will be sent relevant tender documents.

The work will commence on or before 19th April and it is envisaged that the work will take about three months with the potential for a longer period based on demand.
